Mary Ward week.....

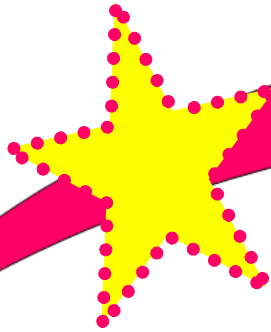
